### General Rules

o Auction buyers shall not be approached to buy back or donate animals to exhibitors.

## **Animal Eligibility**

- o Goats must be officially tagged at Tag-In.
- Eligible animals: Wether or nanny goats only.
- All female goats must have a scrapie tag at official check-in.
- Any breed or crossbreed may be shown. All goats are judged on quality as meat goats.
- Nanny goats showing signs of pregnancy or having kidded before show will not be allowed.

### **Preparation & Show Requirements**

- No artificial paints, powders, or coloring allowed.
- Goats must be sheared with hair no longer than 3/8 inch from the knee up (tail switch excepted).
- Goats must be dehorned or tipped before arrival at the fairgrounds.
- o If tipped, horns must be no smaller than the diameter of a dime.
- No tipping or dehorning will be allowed on fairgrounds.
- No ear tags removed; breeder tags must be taped for show.

### Check-In & Weight

- o Exhibitors may only bring one (1) goat to official check-in.
- o Minimum weight: 60lbs at weigh-in (2 lb variance allowed).
- o Goats will have one (1) official weigh per animal.
- o Classes will be divided by weight (up to four classes).

## Sale

- o 15 goats will make the sale.
- Sale order determined by the Market Goat Judge after selection of Grand Champion and Reserve Champion.
