PARADE RULES CONCERNING FLOATS

1. To be eligible for consideration as a float the entry must meet the following criteria
 - a. Homemade or commercial float of a current queen candidate
 - b. Homemade or commercial float of a business or other entity
 - c. Is not a vehicle only entry. (i.e. - queen candidate riding in a car)
 - d. Is not the float for the previous Youth Fair Queen
 - e. Is Not the float for Needville Youth Fair Officials
2. There will be two (2) divisions:
 - a. Division I -
 - i. Homemade floats - floats constructed by an individual, organization or a Queen Candidate
 - b. Division II -
 - i. Professional floats - floats rented, bought or borrowed from a professional float builder
3. The prizes awarded will be as follows:

Division I		Division II
First Place	\$150.00	For exhibition only
Second Place	\$125.00	No placing or prize
Third Place	\$100.00	Money Awarded
Fourth Place	\$ 85.00	

*If there are two or less floats in Division I only one prize will be awarded.

*Not necessarily all places will be awarded in Division I. If judges decide that an entry does not merit a prize, none will be awarded.

*In the event of a tie in Division I, the judges will determine the final placing.

*All floats will be checked on the day of the parade to verify division (i.e. Division I or Division II)

*Judging will take place during the parade as the floats pass by the announcer stands.
